### **Lake Norman Sail and Power Squadron**

Lake Norman Sail and Power Squadron is a unit of United States Power Squadrons. The non-profit, fraternal organization's purpose is to promote high standards of seamanship, navigation and safe boating for all. The squadron includes sail and power boats.

### **Lake Norman Sailing Club**

The Lake Norman Sailing Club on Captain's Way in Denver is a private, not for profit family owned dock. This is the perfect location to store sailboats on the western side beautiful Lake Norman. No motorized boats are allowed.

### **Lake Norman Yacht Club**

The Lake Norman Yacht Club owns a 28 acre site surrounding a sheltered cove adjacent to a large expanse of Lake Norman. Sailboat racing in a family atmosphere has been promoted by the club since it was first incorporated in 1961. From April to November there are approximately 25 weekend days of scheduled, organized club racing with two races per day. The club has hosted the prestigious Championship of Champions Regatta. The club also has a Junior Program for children between the ages of 8 and 18.

### **Outrigger Yacht Club**

The Outrigger Yacht Club was established in 1974. The club is a member of the Lake Norman Keelboat Council, the South Atlantic Yacht Racing Association and the US Sailing Association. The club promotes seamanship, friendly competition, and social activities for sailors on Lake Norman. Membership is open to anyone with an interest in sailing.

### **Peninsula Yacht Club**

The Peninsula Yacht Club offers a variety of vessels, marine products and services. The club offers premier marina facilities with 410 boat slips and a well protected, deep water cove with easy access to the main channel of Lake Norman.
